Treasurer's Report

We have £301.17 in the bank. Two years worth of Hall fees have been paid (2008 & 2009).

Confirm, no increase in subs. Public Liability Insurance costs us £61 and RHS membership £30. Loveday presented income/expenditure for the dinner which originally showed a deficit of £40, but on inspection the 3 free meals had been double counted (spotted by Richard), so it actually made a profit of £3.50.

We have 62 members in 2009.

Expenses (phone calls, stamps, envelopes etc.) £15 to Sue, £5 to Libby. Agreed unanimously.

Margaret donates the flowers for the Hall tubs.

Cardinham 34th Annual Flower & Vegetable Show will be September 4th.

AGM The committee retires at the next AGM. All agreed to stand again. Sue to send nomination papers to all members. Libby has been chair for a long time, and offered to stand down if another member would like the position. All agreed she is the best person for the job, with her experience and contacts. Loveday & Sue also offered to stand down, but there were no takers for the positions of Treasurer and Secretary!
